Sub: TNAU - Education - UG, PG and Diploma programs - COVID-19
Pandemic - Academic activities - Reschedule - Regarding.

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It has come to the knowledge of the University that COVID-19 is spreading again and some of the students of constituent and affiliated colleges are getting infected. Hence, the following orders are issued with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor for immediate adherence.

1. All first year undergraduate degree programmes in constituent and affiliated colleges will be conducted through **online mode only** till further directions from the University
2. For all II and III year undergraduate degree programmes of constituent and affiliated colleges, after completion of practical examinations, the colleges will be closed till 18th of April 2021.
3. Information on conduct of theory examinations for II & III year students will be communicated separately by the Controller of Examinations. Till such time, course teachers are encouraged to conduct model theory examinations for the benefit of the students through online mode.
4. All final year students undergoing Village Stay Programmes (VSP) are hereby informed to remain in the campus of their stay avoiding tour to outside places. They will be returning to their respective Colleges soon after the completion of the VSP schedule already informed.
5. For the Engineering final year students, the regular classes will be continued as per schedule and the hostel facilities will be provided to them.

6. For the senior students of the Diploma programmes, the regular classes are withheld from 3rd April to 18th April 2021. However, online classes will be conducted for senior students as per time table, similar to I year Diploma students.
7. For first year M.Sc. and Ph.D., the classes will be conducted through online mode only.
8. However, all other PG students (II year & III year and above) shall continue their thesis research without break strictly following SOP for COVID-19.
9. All the other State students (UG, PG and Ph.D) will be permitted to stay in the hostels until they get the travel facilities to reach back home.
10. The digital attendance for all degree programmes has to be adhered strictly. The Dean (Agri.) will monitor the digital attendance for the U.G. programmes in the constituent and affiliated colleges of TNAU. Similarly, the attendance for all PG programs will be monitored by Dean (SPGS).
11. For all the students staying in the hostel, movement outside the campus is strictly prohibited, since it is felt that the spread of COVID-19 to few students is mostly due to outside movement.
12. During travel to home, utmost care is to be followed by the students.
13. After the holidays, the students are advised to bring RTPCR/ Vaccination report on their arrival to the respective campus.
